The afternoon offered space for networking, final conference planning, and sharing project updates. We concluded with break-out sessions for focused exchange and peer-feedback on the upcoming activities.

The "ConnAct for SustainAbility: Berlin City Link Conference | Sustainable Cities, United Efforts: A European Approach" marked the official launch of the ConnACT EU project and brought together over 80 participants from across Europe including municipal representatives, civil society actors, researchers, and EU project partners.

The conference focused on the role of cities in addressing the climate crisis, fostering cross-border cooperation, and strengthening democratic and inclusive urban development. It created a platform for dialogue, learning, and exchange among stakeholders from six partner countries: Germany, Portugal, the Czech Republic, Greece, the Netherlands, and Italy.
